The 1950's was a decade of innovation and transformation. Our nation was on the cusp of developing the polio vaccine, "Singin' in The Rain" premiered at Radio City Music Hall, and the first Chevrolet Corvette prototype was completed. On February 5, 1952, a local merger between three community hospitals established the Albert Einstein Medical Center and ushered in a historic era of healthcare across Philadelphia.

This decade also saw the beginnings of what is now a 70-year Einstein tradition. Initially planned to celebrate the new medical center, the inaugural Harvest Ball raised \$19,000, an astonishing amount in 1952. Decade after decade, the annual gala remains an essential source of funding for Einstein's lifesaving programs and services.

After a two-year hiatus, we will come together on Saturday, November 5, 2022, at the Bellevue Hotel to mark our 70th Annual Harvest Ball. As we honor the traditions of our lon-gest-standing event, we hope you will join us in continuing this important demonstration of philanthropy.

This year's proceeds will help launch the MossRehab Institute for Brain Health (MRIBH), a transformative program designed to enhance access to treatment for Veterans and First Responders experiencing mild-to-moderate traumatic brain injuries, including concussion.

Today, traumatic brain injuries and post-traumatic stress affect nearly 1 out of every 3 military personnel deployed to war zones since 2001. An estimated 30% of our nation's first responders also experience symptoms of depression and post-traumatic stress. In partnership with the Marcus Institute for Brain Health at the University of Colorado Anschutz Medical Campus, this outpatient program will meet and address physical, social, and emotional needs of Veterans and First Responders and provide support for their families.
